

INVITATION TO BID

2011-2012 JAPONSKI ISLAND SEWER LIFT STATION UPGRADES SITKA, ALASKA

The City and Borough of Sitka will receive sealed bids no later than 10:00 a.m. local time, Tuesday, January 17, 2012 at the office of the Municipal Clerk, 100 Lincoln Street, Sitka, Alaska 99835 where the bids will be publicly opened. Bids stamped later than 10:00 a.m. will be rejected.

The work consists of upgrading/replacing six (6) sewage pump lift stations that have reached the end of their service life. The existing pumps are vacuum prime pumps and will be replaced with new state of the art submersible pumps. Work will also include installation of associated piping, valve vaults, wet wells (if applicable), electrical, instrumentation and controls and temporary sewer bypass pumping while the new lift stations are constructed and tested.

All bidders are strongly encouraged to attend the non-mandatory pre-bid meeting scheduled for **10:00 a.m., on Thursday, December 22, 2011** at the City and Borough of Sitka 3rd Floor Conference Room, 100 Lincoln Street, Sitka, Alaska.

This contract is subject to the provisions of State of Alaska, Title 36, Minimum Wage Rates and Federal Davis-Bacon Wage Rates. The contract will require certificates of insurance and performance and payment bonds.

A Bid Bond in the amount of 5 percent of the total bid price must accompany each bid. The Bid Bond may be in the form of a certified or cashier's check made payable to the City and Borough of Sitka or a Bid Bond issued by a surety licensed to do business in Alaska.
